 - Maintain full-time status (at least a 60% course load)
 - Are in need of financial assistance

- **WSD School Board Bursary/Margaret Crawford Bursary**

- **Amount:** Value to be determined by the Superintendent's Department
- **Description:** *The Winnipeg School Division offers a limited number of bursaries for students enrolled in a Winnipeg School Division high school with the exception of Technical-Vocational High School and R.B Russell Vocational High School (Note: Students in these two schools are eligible to apply for a Margaret Crawford Bursary).*
- **Basic Eligibility Requirements:**
 - A Bursary may be awarded to a resident pupil who presently attends a Winnipeg School Division school and who continues to attend a Winnipeg School Division school with resident status. Non-resident pupils are **not** eligible for bursaries even if living in Winnipeg and/or attending a Winnipeg School Division school
 - Bursaries will be awarded only to pupils whose school work is satisfactory in the opinion of the principal and staff
 - Bursaries will be awarded only to pupils who cannot continue their high school courses without this assistance or who can only continue with undue hardship to their families
 - Bursaries may be awarded to pupils at the end of **grades nine, ten or eleven** who are desirous of continuing the work of the next grade.
 - School Board Bursaries apply to all courses offered in a Winnipeg School Division high school **except** Vocational Education
 - Applications must include the parent's or guardian's declaration, a Citizen's reference as indicated on the form. And both the teacher's and principal's recommendation
 - Applications will be received by the principal of the school the applicant is attending, and will be forwarded to the Superintendent's Department. The decision in awarding these bursaries will be final.
 - Pupils granted a bursary at the end of one school grade may apply again in the succeeding grade, provided they remain eligible in other respects
 - The bursary's value will be determined by the Superintendent's Department and is payable in instalments. A bursary is subject to cancellation at any time if the pupil's work is not satisfactory or if economic conditions change materially
 - Any change of address during the year must be made in writing to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Winnipeg School Division as well as to the school
